Commercial Compliance Study

Discovering how commercial buildings use energy; which code requirements go towards those high energy uses; creating a “top 10” checklist for code requirements that have the highest impact; evaluating compliance with design, construction and enforcement of the energy codes.

Energy Rater Gap Study

Research on where and when energy raters are being used to assist in code compliance; discovering road blocks to their use; creating solutions and recommendations that will allow people to use the performance approaches and raters.
