HOUSE BILL NO. 743

Prefiled pursuant to Article III, Section 2(A)(4)(b)(i) of the Constitution of Louisiana.

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 40:1730.42(2) and (6) and 1730.45(A) and (B), relative to the
3 Commercial Building Energy Conservation Code; to provide for the latest editions
4 of the ANSI/ASHRAE/IESNA 90.1 and the International Energy Conservation Code
5 with regards to the Commercial Building Energy Conservation Code; to provide for
6 the scope of the code; and to provide for related matters.

7 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

8 Section 1. R.S. 40:1730.42(2) and (6) and 1730.45(A) and (B) are hereby amended
9 and reenacted to read as follows:

10 §1730.42. Definitions

12 (2) "ANSI/ASHRAE/IESNA 90.1-~~2001~~ 2004", or the latest edition adopted
13 by the state fire marshal, pursuant to the provisions of the Louisiana Administrative
14 Procedure Act, means the document developed by the American National Standards
15 Institute, American Society of Heating, Refrigerating, and Air Conditioning
16 Engineers, and the Illuminating Engineering Society of North America entitled
17 "Energy Standard for Buildings Except Low-Rise Residential Buildings".

19 (6) "International Energy Conservation Code, ~~2000~~ 2006 edition" or the
20 latest edition adopted by the state fire marshal, pursuant to the provisions of the
21 Louisiana Administrative Procedure Act, means the document developed by the

1 International Code Council, Inc., entitled "International Energy Conservation Code",
2 also referred to as "IECC".

4 §1730.45. Adoption of Commercial Building Energy Conservation Code;
5 enforcement; rules

6 A. ANSI/ASHRAE/IESNA 90.1-~~2001~~ 2004, or latest edition promulgated
7 by the state fire marshal, with state amendments, is hereby adopted as the
8 Commercial Building Energy Conservation Code for applicable buildings.

9 B. The International Energy Conservation Code, ~~2000~~ 2006 edition, or latest
10 edition promulgated by the state fire marshal, with state amendments, is hereby
11 adopted as the Commercial Building Energy Conservation Code for applicable
12 buildings not covered by the preceding part.

13 * * *

14 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
15 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
16 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
17 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
18 effective on the day following such approval.
